

Booster Club Activities

August:

1. Boosters pay for renting out the pool, lifeguards, and snacks at the "Welcome to Choir" swim party each August. As part of the swim party, we will host Everything Night to help students and parents with uniform measurements, paying choir and contest fees, booster club enrollment, purchasing merchandising, etc.

September:

1. Boosters provide dinner and snacks (lots and lots of food) for the Choir Retreat and provide volunteers. Parents are asked to donate additional food and drinks for the event. This is an activity for all choir members at the school and is a great bonding experience – and lots of fun!

October:

1. Boosters provide volunteers to chaperone students at the All-State Region Auditions.
2. Boosters pay for a fun Halloween party for all of the kids (lots and lots of food and other fun things).
2. Boosters provide volunteers for the Fall Concert to collect/sell tickets and usher at the doors.

November:

1. Boosters provide volunteers for the Pre-Area Auditions hosted at Anderson from 4:30-10pm. Volunteers will be monitoring auditions or serving food to the judges. Booster parents are also asked to donate food for this event.

December:

1. A fun activity which also raises a lot of money for the Choir Booster Club in past years is Holiday Caroling. It's an optional activity for students. We will need volunteers to drive the kids to various neighborhoods and a home to host the post caroling party. Boosters pay for the caroling party snacks.
2. At the Winter Concert, the Boosters need volunteers to help out at the dinner for the students between the end of school and the beginning of the concert. Boosters will pay for some food items or other supplies at this event. Boosters also provide ushers at the doors during the concert.

January – April:

1. During the Spring semester, Boosters are called upon for the Spring Concert and for occasional volunteer needs and unexpected expenses almost always arise! This will include parent chaperones and food donations.
2. Boosters sponsor a Skate party at Playland Skate Center (date TBD) for both Anderson and Murchison choir students and families. This will be a fun fundraiser for the Booster Club and an opportunity for the kids to spend time with other choir students from Murchison. We will need parent volunteers for the event.

May:

1. Boosters contribute to the cost of Choir Banquet. This is to help keep the cost per student to a minimum so all students can attend. Seniors attend the banquet for free. Boosters pay for the first \$50 towards letter jackets for the seniors who earned them.
2. Boosters pay for the commemorative program at the Senior Celebration Concert. All students perform in this concert. A post-concert end of the year celebration party is held in the choir room where all students and guests are encouraged to attend. It's a fun time for everyone where lots of food and drinks are provided.
